## **DISCIPLINE POLICY**

The Brewster Recreation Department endorses fair and age-appropriate program rules, which ensure a safe and orderly environment. Within our program, participants are expected to adhere to the same behaviors that are required within the classroom. Recreation Department Staff have final say over what is considered appropriate or inappropriate behavior.

When a child's behavior departs from the program's standards of acceptable behavior, any of the following may take place:

- Conference with child and staff members
- Loss of program privileges
- Removal from group
- Parental notification
- Loss of field trip/special event privileges
- Suspension or dismissal from the program

## **SUMMER REC RULES**

### **CHILDREN MUST REMEMBER:**

1. Respect counselors and each other.
2. Stay with your group.
3. No fighting, punching, kicking, biting, spitting, throwing rocks, etc. (keep your hands to yourself).
4. Use appropriate language at all times.
5. Children are not allowed to leave the programming areas.
6. No going into the woods.
7. No loitering in the bathrooms.
8. Leave personal belongings at home (toys, smart devices, game systems, etc.).
9. No gum.

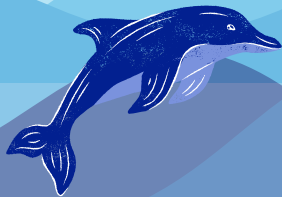


## **PICK-UP & DROP-OFF POLICY:**

**Drop-Off:** Families without children in the pre-K & K program will drop off on the front lawn. There will be one line for vehicle drop-offs and another area for parents who wish to park and walk their child to their group. Caregivers will drop off pre-K & K children and their siblings in front of the Arts Center. **DROP OFF IS FROM 7:45-8:50 AM.** If you are dropping off late, please bring your child to the admin building and a staff member will connect them with their group.

**Pick-Up:** Families without children in the pre-K & K programs will park on the front lawn and walk to their child's group. **PICK UP IS FROM 12-12:15 PM.** Pick-up for pre-K & K children and their siblings will take place in front of the Arts Center. After Rec participants will be picked up following the same procedure. Pick-up for the After Rec program is at 3 PM. If you need to pick your child up early, please let us know in advance and come to the admin building when you arrive.

Do not pass a car that has stopped to drop-off or pick-up a child. Drive slowly and be attentive to other cars and pedestrians. We ask for your patience the first few days, as we work out the kinks! If there is rain or severe weather, drop-off and pick-up procedures are subject to change.



## **TRANSPORTATION POLICY**

The Town of Brewster Recreation Department is not responsible for transportation to or from the program. Employees are prohibited from transporting program participants. Field trip transportation will be provided by bus or van unless there is an illness or behavioral problem during the field trip. In this situation the Recreation Director or Assistant Director will bring the child back to the Bay Property and notify the parent/guardian.
