Brewster Community Pool Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Do I need to be a Brewster resident to go to the pool?

Yes, the pool is only open to residents for Summer 2024. Residents must purchase a pool pass to use the pool. Pool passes must be presented to the pool attendant to enter the pool area. Residents that do have a pool membership but are there for a class will need to be checked off the class attendance list. A 2024 resident beach permit is required to enter the property.

When will the pool be open?

The pool will be open from June 15th through August 18th, from 6am until 6pm daily, except on Wednesdays when the pool will open at noon. Fridays & Saturdays the pool may be rented to residents for private events from 6pm-8pm.

Will the pool be open in bad weather?

The pool will close if it is raining hard or if there are thunderstorms in the area. Lifeguards need to be able to see the bottom of the pool. If there is hazardous weather, the pool will close for a period of time determined by Town staff.

What kinds of memberships do you offer? Costs?

Individual - \$100, Family (same household) - \$200, Individual Senior (aged 70+) - \$75, Two-person households - \$150, Two-person Senior (both persons aged 70+)- \$125

Is having a pool pass required to participate in aquatics classes/swim lessons?

No, a pool pass is not required for residents taking classes. However, you will be required to have a resident beach sticker to get on the property.

As a pool pass holder, can I bring guests with me to the pool?

The Town will offer residents who have purchased a pool pass the chance to purchase 25 guest passes for the 2024 season via the Brewster Recreation website only. Guest passes are not available through the mail-in program or for purchase at the pool. More information will be posted on the website as the date gets closer.

How old does someone have to be to use the pool area without adult supervision?

Anyone 12 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult (18+).

Can I rent the pool or the pavilion for an event?

Yes, there will be the opportunity for residents to rent the pool/pavilion on Friday or Saturday evenings from 6pm-8pm.

Will there be dedicated days/times for lap swim, lessons, and classes?

Yes, please visit the Recreation Department webpage to view the pool schedule including information on lessons and classes. Sign up will be through the Recreation Department and there are additional fees for classes/lessons. www.brewsterrecreation.com.

Will there be dedicated parking for the pool?

Yes, there will be 30+ spaces adjacent to the pool area as well as 4 ADA spaces. There will also be overflow parking near the athletic field.

What is the maximum number of people allowed in the pool area?

Up to 100 persons are allowed in the pool area at one time. The pool area includes the pavilion.

Can I bring any flotation devices?

Floats and inflatables are not allowed in the pool, only US Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are permitted in the pool. The Town will supply kick boards and pool noodles on a limited basis. Adult swimmers may use a water-walking belt.

Am I able to bring food or drink to the pool?

You may have water or other non-alcoholic drinks in the pool area. No glass containers are allowed. All food will need to be limited to the pavilion.

Are there bathrooms and changing facilities?

Yes, there are two bathrooms as well as an ADA porta-potty on site. A changing area with multiple changing stations is located on site.
