What to Wear and Bring *(and what not to!)*

Please, label your child's clothing and belongings

Lost and Found items will be donated at the end of the camp season.



Your child should wear:

- Layered clothes that can get wet and dirty – play clothes
- A hat with a brim for sun protection
- Socks and sneakers or close-toed shoes. No open-toed sandals or “jellies” please!
- insect repellent



Your child should bring a backpack containing:

- An insulated lunch bag with icepack. Please consider packing a low-waste lunch.
- A peanut and tree-nut free snack and lunch.
- Insect repellent/Sunscreen
- A refillable water bottle
- An extra layer for cool days or windy conditions, and a water-proof layer on drizzly days
- A spare set of clothes and/or shoes is recommended for ALL campers each day!



Please leave these items at home:

- Flip-flops, or open “slip on” sandals
- All electronic devices - and hand-held video games (if campers have cell-phones they will remain in the camper's back-packs)
- Personal treasures, collectable cards, and items of value
- ABSOLUTELY NO Pocketknives, matches, firearms and ammunition, or other potentially dangerous items
- **Peanuts/Tree-nuts due to allergy concerns.** Thank you!
